HASCO WIN MAJOR CONTRACT IN TURKEY

Hasco have won a major contract with Mitas Galvaniz in Turkey for the installation of a galvanizing plant for transmission towers together with leading European crane suppliers Ingenia, and pre-treatment solution suppliers Körner kvk.

This will be the fourth galvanizing plant we have worked on with Mitas and the largest capacity, with a high velocity furnace capable of galvanizing up to 25 tonnes of steel every hour!



REPEAT BUSINESS IN HOLLAND

NEW STRATEGY FOR ASIA

Hasco have teamed up with their partner Giardina srl, Italy in order to offer complete galvanizing lines to the ASEAN market. The renewed partnership was introduced at the recent 9th Asia Pacific General Galvanizing Conference in Singapore. The companies had a stand together at the exhibition and Dr Xinyi Liu, who is a research associate at Sheffield University and currently employed by Hasco gave a presentation on the work being carried out on an optimum heating profile for galvanising furnaces.



THIRD FURNACE FOR MELTING ZINC

Hasco have supplied their third high velocity furnace for melting zinc via their long-established agent in Italy, Giardina srl.

The first two were supplied to Metalsider 2 and one more recently to Nuovo Eurozinco.

Traditionally smelting companies have had to accept relatively short kettle lives but with new thinking in furnace design, this no longer has to be the case.
